The Cheyenne Symphony Orchestra's Board of Directors is proud to announce the promotion of Dr. Lindsey Bird Reynolds to the position of Executive Director of the Cheyenne Symphony. Reynolds says she's ready to lead the Symphony while exploring some fresh ideas, "in my new role with CSO, I am very excited to embrace the challenge of reaching out to the community and expanding our audience. The 2016/17 season has many opportunities to bring people in, like a concert of John William's movie music, and new season program packages geared towards allowing subscribers to sample what CSO has to offer."

Reynolds adds that the Symphony has a lot of entertainment for the whole family, "I am particularly excited about the Family matinee in January, which will include an instrument petting zoo in the lobby for families to come and explore hands-on the instruments of the orchestra."


